



ORDER OF APPEARANCE

- All parade entries and participants are selected by the Parade Committee aiming to create a diverse and engaging lineup.
- The parade committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- The Parade Committee will determine the order of appearance for the Parade. The order is determined to establish variety, as well as the best utilization of the participants.
- Lineup position cannot be changed once assigned.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Participants must conduct themselves with courtesy, safety, and community spirit at all times during assembly, parade execution, and dispersal.

VEHICLES & PARTICIPANTS

- All vehicles must carry valid insurance and be operated by licensed drivers.
- Vehicle occupancy must not exceed seatbelt limits.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

- Alcohol and drug use are strictly prohibited for all participants. Violators will be removed from the parade.

PACING & SPACING

- Parade Participants must maintain a consistent pace with no gaps.
- Keep a minimum of 10 feet from the curb and 40 feet from the unit ahead.
- There is a speed limit of 5 mph for all units including motorcycles. No maneuvers will be allowed.

DISTRIBUTED ITEMS

Absolutely no candy, flyers or merchandise will be thrown or distributed along the parade route. If you would like to provide candy for the parade please drop it off to the MHPA tent and we will put it out for event goers to enjoy.



ASSEMBLY/STAGING AREA

- Floats may begin arriving for staging at 4:00 p.m. All floats should be mostly parade-ready, with only minor decorative additions needed on site.
- All units and participants must be in the designated staging area and checked in with the Parade Committee by 6:00 p.m.
- Parade lineup will begin promptly at 6:30 p.m., with the parade beginning at 7:30 p.m.

DISPERSAL AREA

- The parade will proceed along Edgewood Avenue, and units may begin dispersing after passing Plymouth Street.

Payment

- The participation fee for the parade is \$20. This fee may be waived for schools and nonprofit organizations.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

- In the event of severe weather, the Parade Committee will consult with emergency officials to determine cancellation or Murray Hill-O-Ween Parade Rules & Guidelines delay.
- Refund of registration fees will not be provided due to inclement weather.

ENFORCEMENT

- These rules are strictly enforced by parade officials and law enforcement. Non-compliance will result in the inability to participate in the parade.
